


Commodore-64

Commodore Business Machines (CBM) Inc. is a subsidiary of Commodore International Ltd., a Canadian-based company founded in 1958 to manufacture and market electromechanical calculators and adding machines.

CBM was formed in 1976 following acquisition by Commodore of MOS Technology, Inc., developers of the industry standard 6502 microprocessor chip. Commodore pioneered the personal computing industry with a 4KB version of the PET computer introduced in 1977.

SYSTEM CHARACTERISTICS

The Commodore-64 is a 64K byte upgraded version of the VIC 20. It is geared to the home/hobbyist market and will play video games, perform computing functions, and synthesize music through hook-ups with stereo and hi-fi systems.

The system comes with a full 66-key typewriter keyboard with upper and lower text capability, function keys, graphics characters, a cartridge game slot and game controllers. Its audio capabilities include sound generation, polyphonic tone, music synthesization, and hi-fi output.

Besides performing the normal computing functions such as record keeping, communications and word processing the Commodore-64 has a number of advanced graphic functions. Up to 256 movable objects can be defined and easily moved to created sophisticated game and business graphics.

The system attaches to a user-supplied color TV or monitor. Commodore offers a 30 cps printer for hard copy output, a modem to access telecomputing services such as Dow Jones and The Source, and a floppy diskette drive for greater storage capacity.

Because Commodore-64 will run under the CP/M operating system, various applications from independent vendors can be utilized. Additionally, Commodore is presently in the process of converting the VIC game cartridges to run on the new system.
